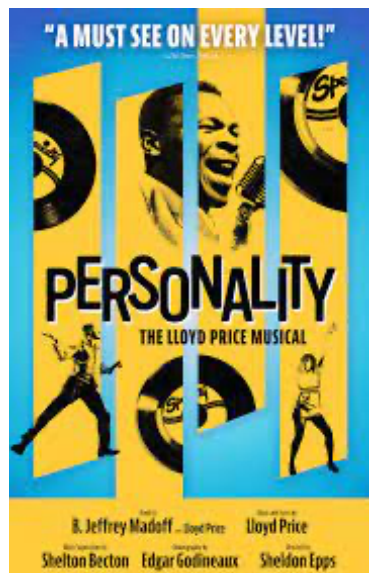

We all know about the unifying power of music, and no one's sound brought people together quite like the trailblazing Lloyd Price who became a legend in the 20th century. In 1952, Price recorded his first record, "Lawdy Miss Clawdy." Price became a crossover hit, popular with both Black and White kids, breaking down the "race records" barrier in the industry. Lloyd was the *first* teenager to sell over a million records, *first* black teenager to get airplay on White stations and the *first* artist to start their own record label. Price dreamed and achieved change through his music, manner, and mindset. He defined the times and inspired people of all races and ages. Lloyd Price was inducted into the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame in 1998 — this musical celebrates his life and legacy.

**Halim Time & Glass Museum.** One suburban man and his family are passionate about time and starting next week they want you to make time to see their personally curated collection. There are so many pieces they decided to build a museum to house and display them. It's located in Evanston and houses over 1100 time pieces and over 70 stained glass pieces of art. The building is five stories tall and is filled with history, art and the study of time. (*Elevator accessible*).

**Charles Gates Dawes' magnificent home**, now a National Historic Landmark, was built by Dr. Robert Sheppard in 1894 on two acres overlooking Lake Michigan. It served as the Dawes family home from 1909 until 1957. Faithfully restored and carefully conserved, this chateausque residence, designed by architect Henry Edwards-Ficken, of New York, has twenty-five rooms, including a cherry paneled library, a vaulted dining room with a musicians' gallery, six bedrooms, and twelve fireplaces. *Stairs*

**Frances Willard Home** another National Historic Landmark, built in 1865, and patterned after a design by Andrew J. Downing, this Evanston house was home to Frances Willard (1839-1898). Both author and activist, Frances Willard lived and worked in this house during the years of her presidency of the Woman's Christian Temperance Union (WCTU). For many of those years, the house also served as an informal national headquarters for the WCTU and a boarding house for its workers.

## Christmas Markets of Montreal & Quebec City

### DAY 1: ARRIVE MONTREAL

### Day 1: Thursday, February 1, 2024 • Departure to Maui

Our journey begins as we board our flight bound for Aloha, Hawai'i! Our tour starts with our departure from O'Hare International Airport this morning on our flights to Maui's Kalului Airport. After breakfast we get a taste of Hawaii at the **Maui Tropical Plantation**. The **Tropical Express train** takes us on a loop around the plantation lagoon, and back into areas of the property that are accessible only by train. We learn about

fruits, vegetables, other cash crops and native plants. We also have time to visit the **Kumu Farms Country Market and Malama Studios** where local artists display and sell their work. Then we get close to the sea at the **Maui Ocean Center**. We learn about the spiritual connection between native Hawai'ians and their aquatic home. We explore the reef ecosystem, open water marine life, turtles, whales and more. We have a pizza party at our hotel this evening. (B, D)

### Day 3: Saturday, February 3, 2024 • Maui

We see a bit of West Maui today as we venture around the base of the mountain to the iconic **'Iao Valley**. Emerald green peaks surround the Iao Needle, standing tall at 1200 ft. We view the valley from a lookout station, and then continue to a short hike (with stairs) to the observation deck. On the way back we stop briefly at

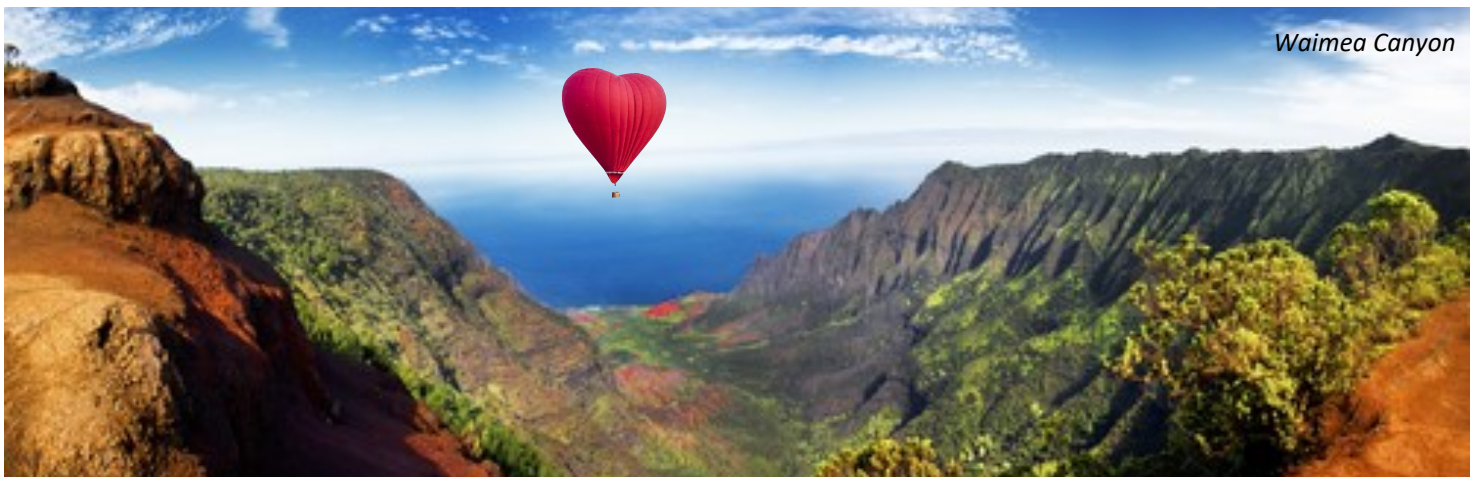
**Day 7: Wednesday, February 7, 2024 •**
