

Theater in the historic Fine Arts Building. We all know about the unifying power of music, and no one's sound brought people together quite like the trailblazing Lloyd Price who became a legend in the 20th century. In 1952, Price recorded his first record, "Lawdy Miss

Clawdy." Price became a crossover hit, popular with both Black and White kids, breaking down the "race records"

barrier in the industry. Lloyd was the first teenager to sell over a million records, first black teenager to get airplay on White stations and the *first* artist to start their own record label. Price dreamed and achieved change through his music, manner, and mindset. He defined the times and inspired people of all races and ages. Lloyd Price was inducted into the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame in 1998 — this musical celebrates his life and legacy.



Take a **Step Back in Time**to tour 3 docent lead amazing homes and museums in Evanston, Ill. Then enjoy lunch at Fire House Grill Burger or sandwich choice that day, with fries or fruit beverage soda or coffee

Halim Time & Glass Museum. One suburban man and his family are passionate about time and starting next week they want you to make time to see their personally curated collection. There are so many pieces they decided to build a museum to house and display them. It's located in Evanston and houses over 1100 time pieces and over 70 stained glass pieces of art. The building is five stories tall and is filled with history, art and the study of time. (Elevator accessible).

Charles Gates Dawes' magnificent home, now a National Historic Landmark, was built by Dr. Robert Sheppard in 1894 on two acres overlooking Lake Michigan. It served as the Dawes family home from 1909 until 1957. Faithfully restored and carefully conserved, this chateauesque residence, designed by architect Henry Edwards-Ficken, of New York, has twenty-five rooms, including a cherry paneled library, a vaulted dining room with a musicians' gallery, six bedrooms, and twelve fireplaces. Stairs

Frances Willard Home another National Historic Landmark, built in 1865, and patterned after a design by Andrew J. Downing, this Evanston house was home to Frances Willard (1839-1898). Both author and activist, Frances Willard lived and worked in this house during the years of her presidency of the Woman's Christian Temperance Union (WCTU). For many of those years, the house also served as an informal national headquarters for the WCTU and a boarding house for its workers.



Christmas Markets of Montreal & Quebec City

DAY 1: ARRIVE MONTREAL

Upon arrival in Montreal meet your Tour Director and transfer to your hotel for a two-night stay in Montreal. 
